RFP SECTION 3. PROPOSAL INSTRUCTIONS, CONTENT, AND FORMAT

3.2 Delivery of Proposal

Bidders are required to submit their proposals electronically on or before **11th September 2026 at 5:00 PM (EDT)**. Submissions delivered by fax, physical copy, or any method other than electronic submission will not be accepted. Late submissions, including any revisions or amendments received after the deadline, will not be considered.

Each submission must be made electronically and comprise the following **two separate documents**:

1. **Technical Proposal** – This document must include the complete technical submission, including the digitally signed transmittal letter required under Section 3.15.2. Supporting documents may be included as appendices or submitted as separate files, provided they are clearly labeled.
2. **Cost Proposal** – This document must include the costs associated with the acquisition, implementation, and ongoing maintenance of the proposed solution required under Section 3.15.8, and it must be submitted separately from the Technical Proposal.
